POLICY & PROCEDURE

Broken Electrical Meter Seals

The electrical service provider will advise the Building Safety Division when a seal has been broken on an electrical meter before the seal is replaced. The Building Safety Division will conduct an inspection to determine permit requirements if a permit has not been issued. If a permit is required the Owner/occupant will be informed that he has a certain number of days, as determined by the inspector and stated on the inspection slip, to obtain an electrical permit or the provider will be contracted and told to pull the meter. Be sure the owner/occupant gets a copy of the inspection slip.

The Building Safety Division will notify the provider when a cut seal is found and, if there exist a potential hazard, request that the meter be removed. Building Safety will contact the owner to notify them that the service is to be discontinued until permits are obtained and the service approved.

The provider will be contacted when the meter may be sealed similar to what is done now to get a meter installed.
