## POLICY AND PROCEDURE

### Electrical: "Minor work" defined

The Building Code and City of Fayetteville Ordinance exempts "minor work" on electrical systems from the requirement to obtain permits. This policy defines some examples of "minor work".


Note that all work must be done in accordance with the Rules and Regulations propagated by the Arkansas Board of Electrical Examiners and the National Electrical Code regardless if a permit is required or not.

"Minor work" does not involve the relocation, installation and/or extension of any part of the electrical system.

Examples of "minor work" are: the replacement of bulbs, luminaries, switches, outlets, ballasts, breakers, fuses, over-current devices and similar equipment.

*Reason:* For consistency in permitting and inspection policies.
