## POLICY & PROCEDURE

### Number of violations that results in a “Not Ready for Inspection”

When an inspection is requested it is assumed that the contractor has reviewed the work for code compliance. When an inspector arrives at a site and notes that at least 5 major violations exist, he may note “not ready for inspection” on the inspection slip. This means that no inspection has been performed and a re-inspection is required. The inspectors will request the contractor to once again review his work for code compliance before he requests an inspection and will help clarify any issues and answer any questions.

REASON: Inspections are sometimes requested before the work is ready. This is to save the inspector and the contractor the additional work required to note all the items that are not yet completed.
