CHAPTER 110: ADVERTISING*

110.01 Billposting

- (A) The posting of any bills, notices, or advertisements of any kind whatever upon any electric light, telephone, or telegraph pole within the limits of the city is hereby prohibited.
- (B) It shall be unlawful for any person to post, stick, paint, or otherwise attach (or cause to be posted, stuck, painted, or caused to be otherwise attached) any bill sign, notice, poster, or other advertisement to any building, fence, wall, vehicles, or other property, public or private, without first having obtained permission from the owner of such property.
