

PARK BOUNDARY SIGNS POLICY

(Projects that require park land dedication)

1. Parks and Recreation receives deed for park land dedication property and signs final plat.
2. Parks and Recreation Staff will contact the developer to coordinate delivery or pick-up of park boundary signs, posts and hardware. The exact number of signs will be determined by the legal description of park property; a sign will be provided for each corner of the property.
3. The developer's surveyor will install signs per the legal description and will contact Parks and Recreation Staff upon completion.

ACCEPTING PARK LAND

(Projects that require park land dedication)

Please be aware that dumping on park property is prohibited in the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas Code of Ordinance Chapter 97. When building your subdivision, please do not use park land to store building supplies, trash or debris.

Final plats will not be signed until the park land is free from all debris.
