



FAYETTEVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT 2011 Annual Traffic Report

The Fayetteville Police Department is committed to assisting the citizens of Fayetteville in traveling its roadways in a safe and efficient manner. In 2011, however, the department documented a slight increase in the number of motor vehicle collisions. Statistics regarding motor vehicle collision and various traffic violations are noted in the below chart.
