Dear Resident,

Stanton Avenue has been selected to receive a sidewalk along the east side from Hilldale Drive to Old Wire Road as part of the city of Fayetteville Capital Improvement Program.

This section is part of a larger project to construct a sidewalk connection from Rolling Hills Drive to Old Wire Road. Other sections will include a sidewalk along the east side of Loxley Avenue between Rolling Hills Drive and Hilldale Avenue and along the north side of Hilldale Avenue from Loxley Avenue to Stanton Avenue.

Construction will require excavation of an area approximately 6 feet behind the curb in preparation for the new sidewalk and will also require removal and replacement of a portion of your driveway approach.

Your driveway approach will be modified to allow the sidewalk to be constructed to current ADA requirements. Existing approaches will be removed and gravel placed temporary to allow continued use of your drive until the fresh concrete is poured. After the new concrete has been poured, you will be unable to use the driveway approach to your residence for approximately two (2) days. This will allow the concrete to cure and gain the necessary strength to support traffic loads. (The crew foreman will work with each resident on the exact schedule.) Lawn areas disrupted by construction will be repaired with new topsoil, seed, and straw.

Please note: If you have flowers, shrubs, sprinkler systems or other items which will need to be moved or protected within the work area please notify the crew foreman or call the Transportation Division office to make arrangements.

Preliminary work will begin the last week of December and continue through February 2011. Scheduled work hours will be 7:00 a.m. until approximately 3:00 p.m. each day. Construction will require reducing traffic to one lane in the work area, during the work day. Residents will be allowed access.

We regret the inconvenience this may cause, however this will allow needed improvements to be made.
