Section 50.20 of the Fayetteville City Code provides that certain disabled persons meeting uniform requirements, will be provided house to curb service at the rate for curbside collection service. In order to qualify for the exemption program, a city resident must be able to provide state documentation proving that they are physically handicapped to the extent that they are substantially impaired from being able to transport household garbage and recycling from their residence to the designated place for collection at the curb, street, or alleyway. There must also be no one residing at that address over the age of twelve (12) years, who would be able to transport such waste from their residence to the designated place for collection.

Citizens wishing to remain on the exemption list will also be required to provide proof of their disability by showing current state documentation that they are eligible for the Disabled Parking passes or are eligible by written documentation from their physician. Once the new application is received, a City of Fayetteville representative will contact you and inform you of your exemption status.
